On 23 January 2006, a roundtable of the business community was held in Athens – organized by the Suzanne Mubarak Women's International Peace Movement, under the auspices of the Greek Ministry of Foreign Affairs, co-sponsored by DCAF, IOM, UNIFEM, UNODC, World Bank and the Foundation for Child and Family and co-hosted by Motor Oil Hellas – where a code of conduct called the Athens Ethical Principles was formally adopted.
